Father of the child left home in search of livelihood. He has not come back for a long time. The mother works as a coolie in the agricultural field of others with a meager income. She cannot feed or cloths her children properly. The children live as beggars in the streets. Due to extreme poverty in the family none of the children are able to attend school. This boy is desperately needy.

**ANJALI SUNA****DATE OF BIRTH: January 1, 2001**

The father and mother of the child are divorced. The child was left with her grandparents and the grandparents are suffering from asthma and low blood pressure. They cannot work and earn money to feed Anjali. Due to poverty they cannot arrange to pay for medicine and are unable to find their daily food. Many time they go to bed without food. There is lack of clothing and living facilities with the grandparents. Currently the child is not going to school.



## **Tikeswar Bag**

**Birthday: August 13, 2000**

Tikeswar's parent live in the jungle village. They collect fire-wood and sell it in the local market to earn their livelihood. May times they go starving because they are poor. They also eat the roots of the forests; they are not able to take care of the child.



## **Rajanti Digal**

**Birthday: May 18, 1999**

Rajanti's mother died due to a brain fever. She had drastic Malaria fever for a three months. They live in the hills and do not have any medical facility. The Father is poverty stricken and can not provide for the child.



## **Jyotsna Duria**

**Birthday: August 12, 2000**

Jyotsna was abandoned by her father after the death of the child's mother. The Father went away by getting married to another woman. The child suffers a lot of weakness. She is not having anything to eat and there is no way left except to beg in the streets.
